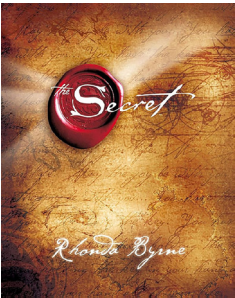

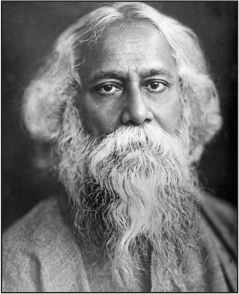

Rabindranath Tagore

The literature Nobel Prize in 1913 was awarded to Rabindranath Tagore, making him the first non-European and the first Asian and the only Indian to receive the honour.Tagore received Nobel Prize for Gitanjali (song offerings), a collection of poems. Prize motivation: “because of his profoundly sensitive, fresh and beautiful verse, by which, with consummate skill, he has made his poetic thought, expressed in his own English words, a part of the literature of the West.” Gitanjali (Song Offerings), Gora (Fair-Faced) and Ghare-Baire (The Home and the World) are his best-known works, and his verse, short stories, and novels were acclaimed—or panned—for their lyricism, colloquialism, naturalism, and unnatural contemplation. His compositions were chosen by two nations as national anthems: India’s “Jana GanaMana” and Bangladesh’s “Amar Shonar Bangla”. The Sri Lankan national anthem was also inspired by his work. His song “Banglar-MatiBanglarJol” has been adopted as the state anthem of West Bengal.
